1. Install the signed WMDIO Driver

1.1 Installation Files

Please select the driver for the corresponding operating system.

In each directory, it includes following files.

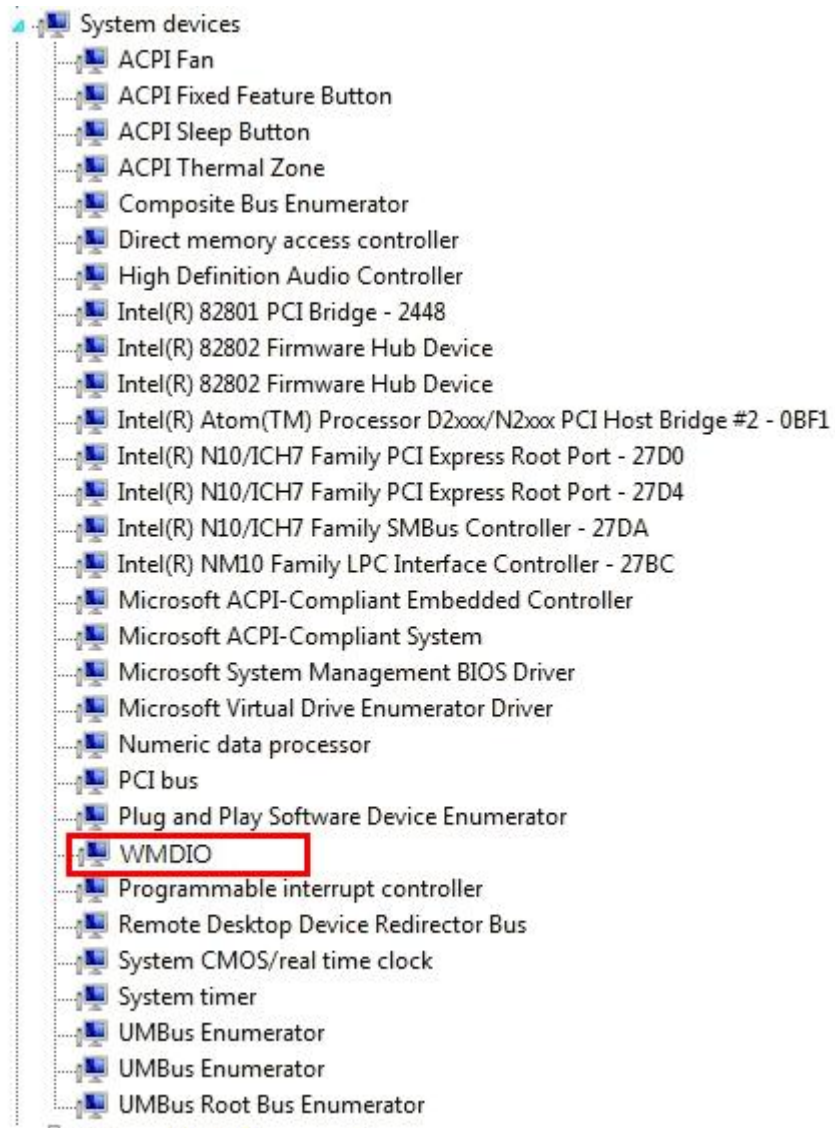


Devcon.exe	Driver application

Wmdio.sys	WMDIO Driver

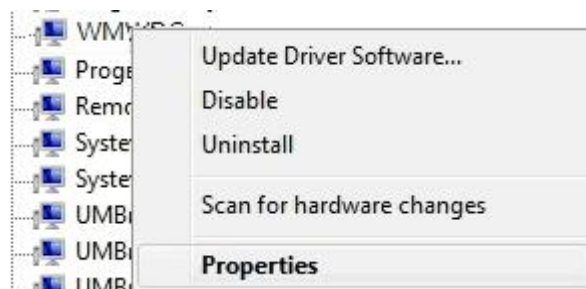
1.2 Installation Procedure

A. Uninstall the old Version.

Before you start to install the new signature WMDIO driver, please remove the old WMDIO driver in Windows's Device Manager.



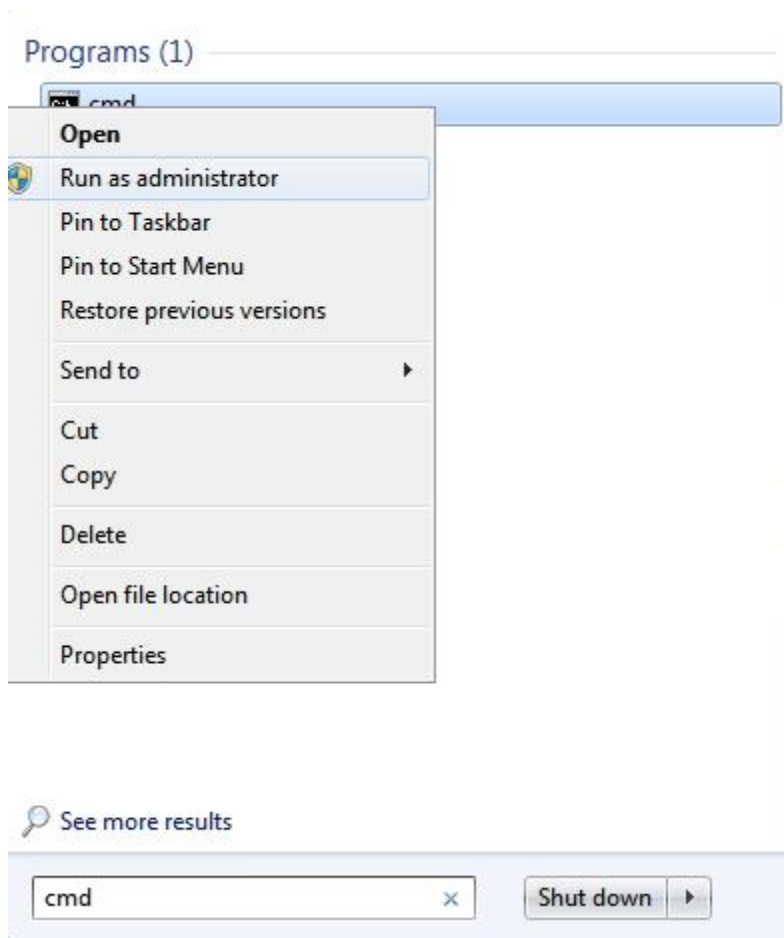
Select “WMDIO” under System devices and right-click it. Use **Uninstall** selection to remove the driver.



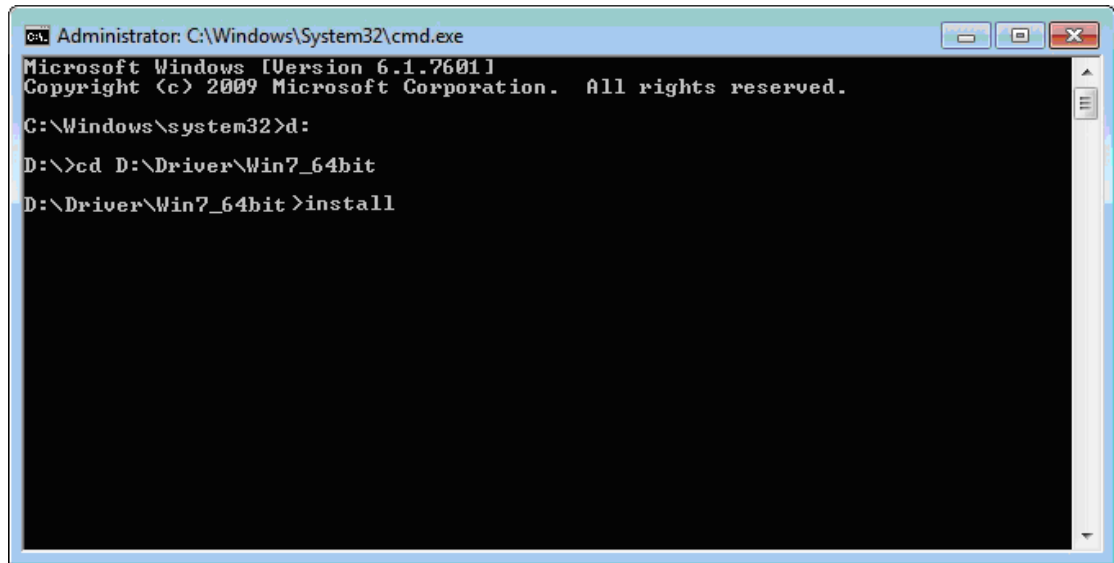


B. Install the driver

1. Type "cmd" in the run box.
2. The cmd.exe will appear in Programs
3. Right click on the cmd.exe and click on "Run as administrator" to start command prompt.



4. Change directory to driver's location, and type **install** to install the driver



5. When Windows Security dialog appear, select **install** to continue the installation.



When the driver is successfully installed, you can see "Drivers Updated successfully" message in the dos prompt.

And "WMDIO" device also added in the Device Manger under "System devices"
